






### Who We Are

**NSBE Mission** & Objectives. The **mission** of the National Society of Black Engineers is "to increase the number of culturally responsible Black Engineers who excel academically, succeed professionally and positively impact the community."

- Pre-College Initiative (PCI): We stimulate the interest in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics fields (STEM) for K-12 students in Berkeley, Charleston, and Dorchester counties.
